Ref: STRONG OPPOSITION TO THE PROPOSED SOLID WASTE TRANSFER STATION

Dear: Honorable Mayor Daniella Levine Cava:

We are writing on behalf of the Bonita Lakes Property Owners Association to express our strong opposition to the proposed solid waste transfer station planned for Location- Lying West of the CSX Rail Right-Of-Way and South of Theoretical SW 136 Street, Miami-Dade County, FL (Application # Z2023000426) . As a community of 517 homes, we are deeply concerned about the numerous adverse impacts this project will have on our neighborhood. Below, we outline the reasons for our opposition:

- 1. **Unpleasant Odors:** The storage and transfer of solid waste materials will inevitably lead to the release of foul and pervasive odors, significantly affecting the comfort and well-being of residents.
- 2. **Noise Pollution:** Operations involving heavy machinery and increased truck traffic will generate substantial noise, disrupting the peace and tranquility that our community values.

- 3. **Light Pollution:** Bright lighting from the station's infrastructure, particularly during nighttime hours, will invade our homes and disturb residents' ability to rest peacefully.
- 4. **Environmental Impacts**: The potential for improper waste management raises concerns about harm to the local environment, including risks to water quality, nearby green spaces, and wildlife habitats.
- 5. **Health Risks:** Exposure to air pollutants and odor-related issues poses health risks, particularly for vulnerable groups such as children, the elderly, and those with preexisting respiratory conditions.
- 6. **Community Unity:** This proposal has united our community in opposition, as we strive to preserve the quality of life and safety for all families in Bonita Lakes.
- 7. **Economic and Social Effects:** The establishment of a transfer station in proximity to our neighborhood will likely reduce property values, deter prospective residents and businesses, and alter the socioeconomic makeup of our area.
- 8. *Alternative Solutions: We urge you to explore alternative locations for the solid waste transfer station, such as industrial zones or areas specifically designed to handle waste management. These options would minimize disruptions to residential communities while still addressing waste management needs.

The residents of Bonita Lakes have chosen this community for its family-friendly environment, safety, and overall quality of life. We implore you to prioritize these values when making decisions about the location of this facility.

Thank you for your attention to this matter. We hope you will take into consideration the strong opposition from our community and seek a solution that aligns with the well-being of local residents.
